

Middle School STEM Activity 3

Subject: Mathematics

Topic: Statistics and Data Analysis

Grade Level: 6-8

Objective: Students will engage in hands-on STEM investigation and apply critical thinking skills.

Students will:

- Analyze scientific or mathematical concepts
- Conduct investigations and record results
- Apply problem-solving and collaboration skills

Materials Needed:

- Notebook
- Pencil
- Basic classroom materials
- Measuring tools (if needed)

Activity Steps:

1. Introduce concept
2. Demonstrate activity
3. Students perform investigation
4. Record data
5. Discuss findings
6. Present results
